The 2022 Masterstudio envisages a form of urban living that is based on principles of collective ownership and ecological lifestyle. It moves beyond the logics of individualism, interpersonal competition, and never-ending wasteful consumption. The studio will provide the setting to rethink the architecture, urban design, and planning of cities in a way that promotes interpersonal cooperation and empathy, reduction of consumption and waste, healthy ecologies and a synergic relation between nature and built environment. To do so, it will explore practice of commoning in cities, low impact living and real-life ecological imaginaries of place.
